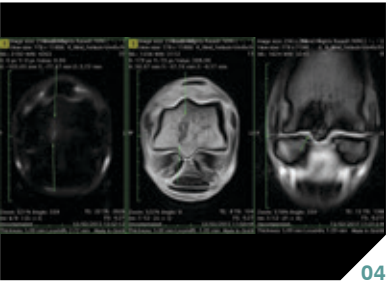
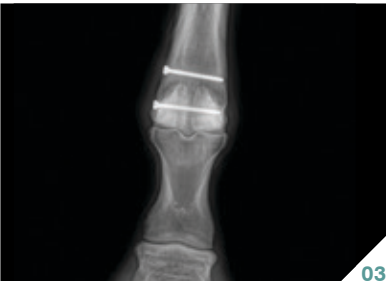
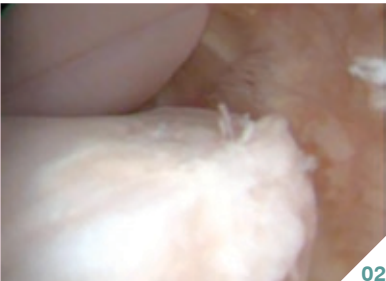
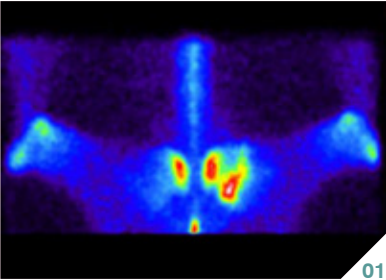
Services

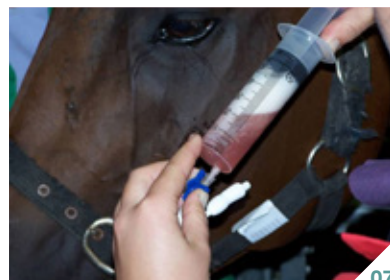

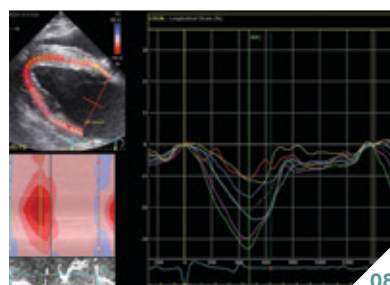

Laryngeal re-innervation

A solution for performance horses with laryngeal paralysis?

- Recent research has shown that the paralysed equine larynx can be treated by implanting a branch of another nerve thereby restoring airway function
- After nerve implantation it takes 6-9 months for function to return, horses can be trained during this time
- The procedure is most suitable for young horses prior to entering full training but can be performed in any animal
- The procedure cannot make the paralysis worse
- Horses that do not respond to treatment can still be treated with a tieback at a later date
- The Dick Vet Equine Hospital is the only clinic in Scotland, and one of the few clinics in the world offering this service

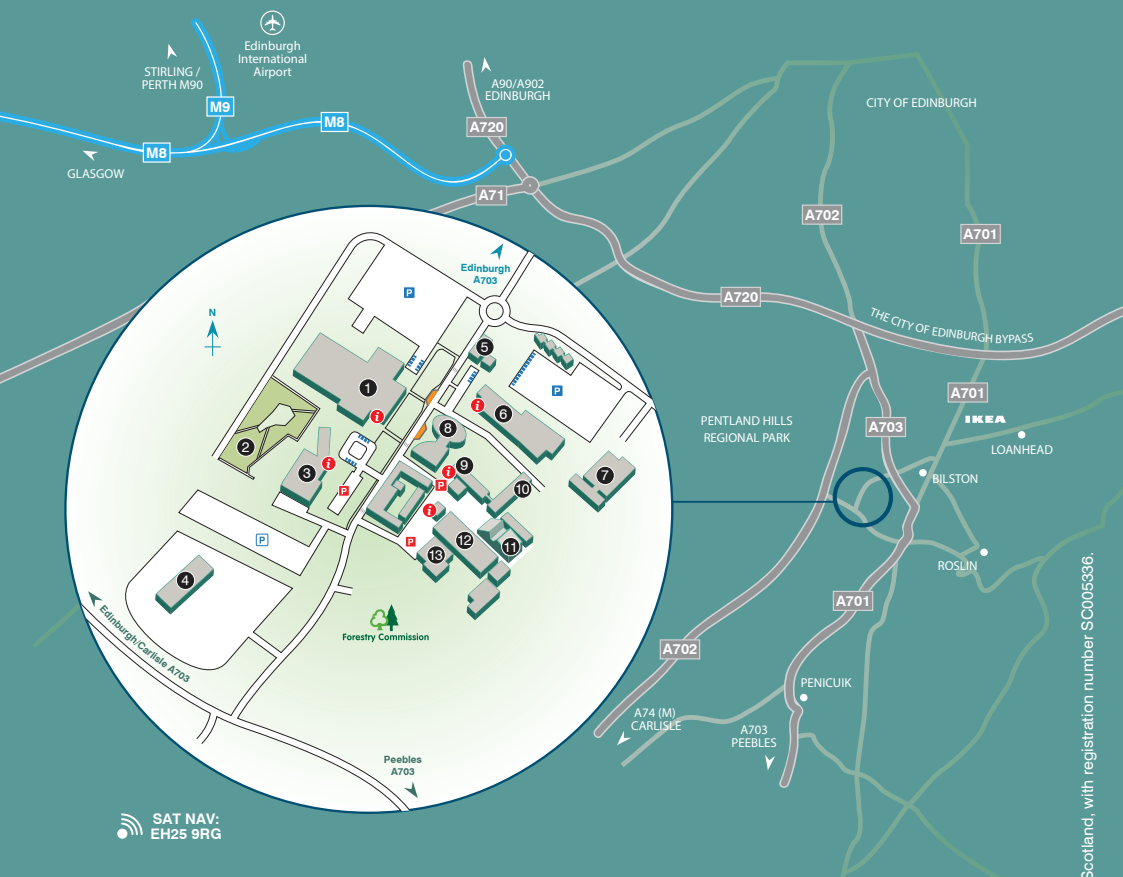
