# Dog Welfare Assessment App: Using the data



The Dog Welfare Assessment app has been developed to allow you to self-assess the welfare of dogs in your CNR (catch neuter return) programme. This is important in order to identify potential problems and take corrective action, to ensure that dog welfare is as positive as it can be.

You can have an instant overview of your activity by accessing the data you have collected by using the **scorecard** and selecting the stage you want to review. Please see the guide on accessing the data and scorecard.

For reporting purposes and analysis, the data download (csv) will be emailed to you. These files will be beneficial to your organisation, as they will provide a detailed overview of your activity. This will enable you to report on your organisation, as well as take corrective action to improve dog welfare.







## Viewing the scorecard data and selecting a date range







By clicking on the download button (highlighted above), your data will be emailed to you

- Reports: The data can be used for reporting purposes to your managers/funders/charity
