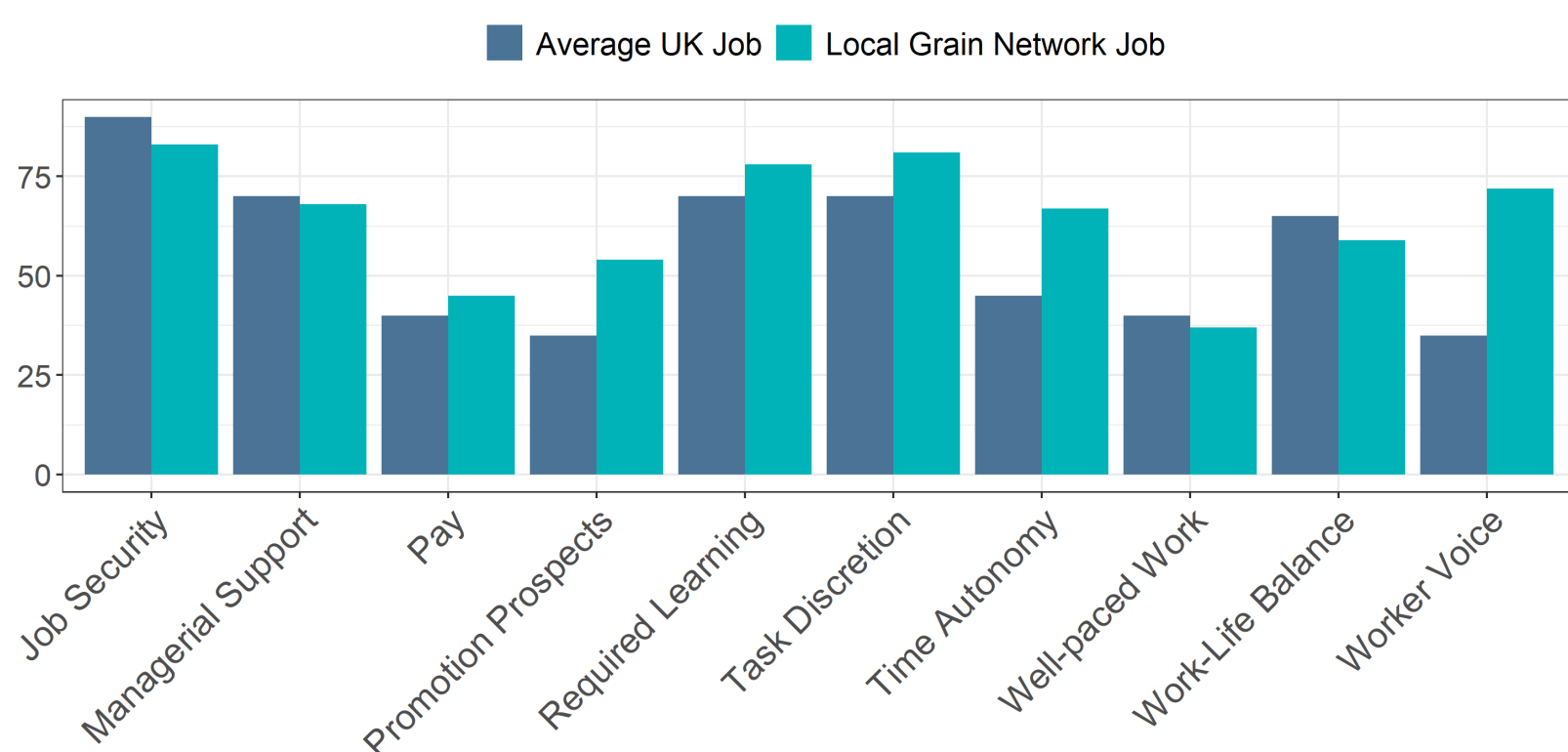
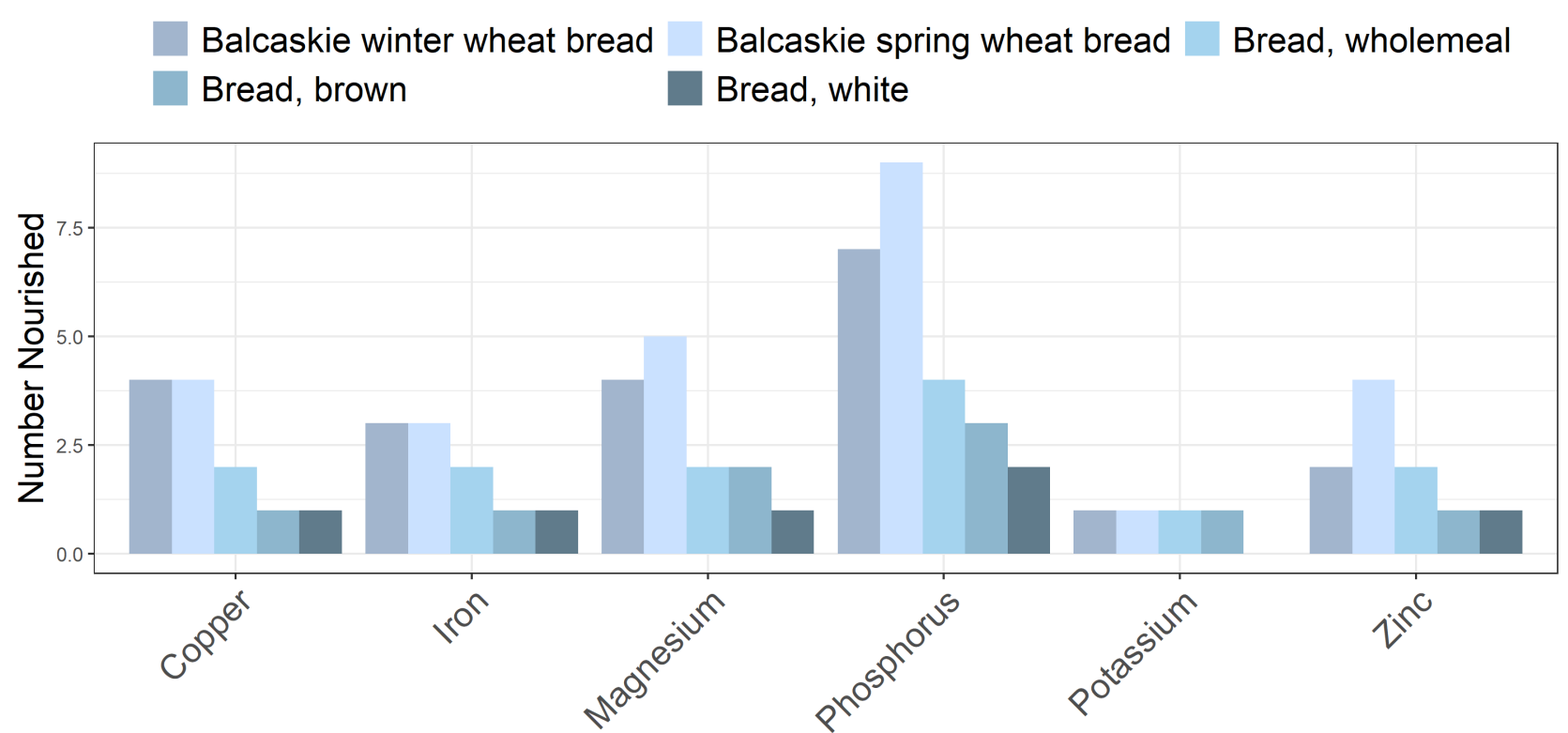
METRICS USED TO EVALUATE THE PERFORMANCE OF AGRICULTURE HAVE NOT CHANGED IN OVER 100 YEARS

Calculating the **number of people and jobs nourished per hectare** could better inform land use in Scotland than yield alone.
